As part of the Ministry of Education's implementation of the refreshed New Zealand Curriculum, schools across the country are introducing changed and aligned reporting systems that better sit alongside with the new curriculum expectations in Literacy and Mathematics.

With our Mid Year Report, families will notice some changes in our student reports. The new reports have been developed by others to provide information about your child's progress, achievement, strengths, and next learning steps. You will also see new curriculum language and achievement descriptors that reflect the expectations outlined in the refreshed curriculum.

To support parents in understanding these changes, our conferences will be 15-minutes long, which will be held at the end of the term. These meetings will provide an opportunity for teachers to explain your child's report, discuss the new terms and meanings, discuss progress and achievement, answer any questions and work together to identify ways to support learning both at school and at home. We understand that new reporting formats can take time to become familiar with and we appreciate your support as we transition to this nationally required approach.

Congratulations to all of our students who participated in last week's Cross Country event. We were incredibly proud of the determination, resilience and sportsmanship displayed by every runner. Well done to those students who qualified for the next stage—we wish you all the very best.

All the best to those going on to represent South Canterbury at the Regionals.



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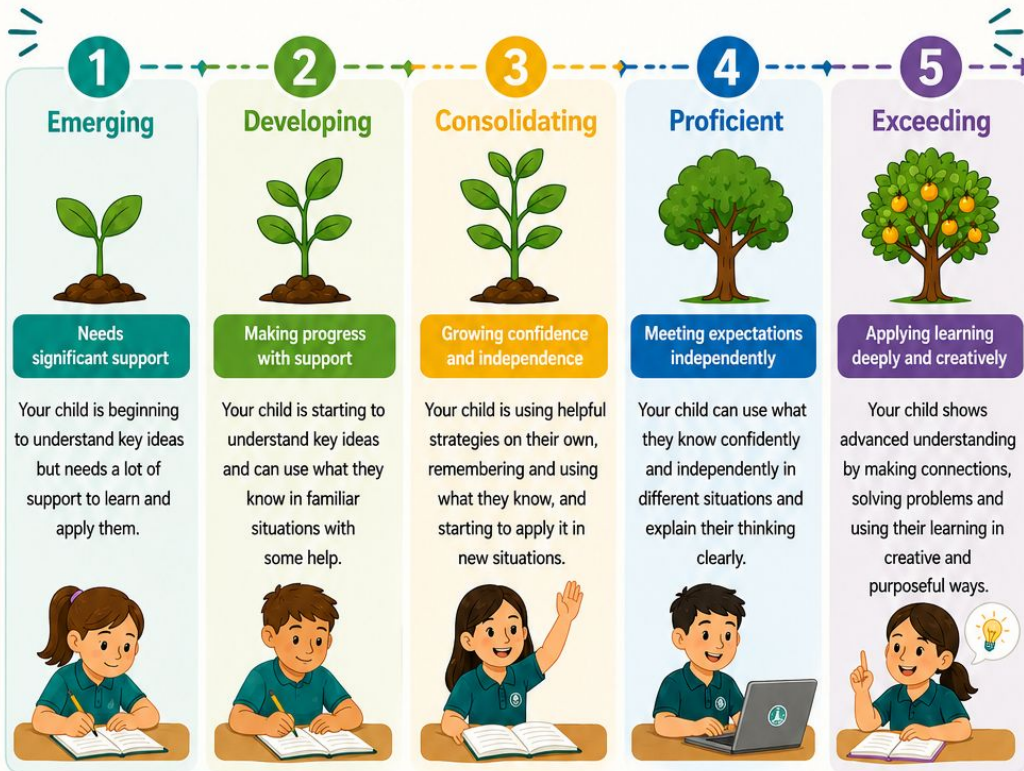

Please be aware that it is a full system change so it will be very challenging to compare 2025 with 2026.



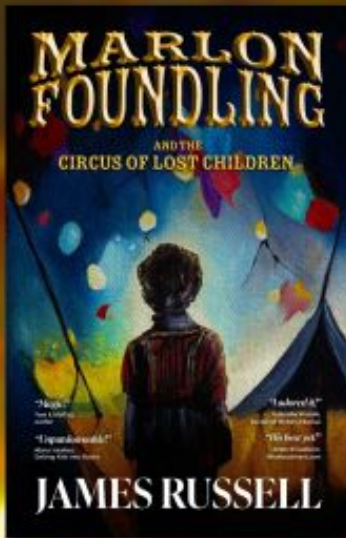
